GARDEN COUNTY SCHOOLS' BUDGET HEARING MINUTES

(Pending September Board Approval)

A public hearing to review the proposed 2017-18 budget took place in the Board Room on Monday, September 4, 2017, at Garden County High School, Oshkosh, NE.

Present were: President Randy Stanczyk, Vice-president Richard Paisley, Treasurer Mike Fischer, Secretary Andrea Lake, Members: Matt Ardissono, Kelly Reece, and Superintendent Paula Sissel

1. The public hearing was called to order by President Stanczyk at 6:32 PM for the purposes of hearing support, opposition, criticism, suggestions, or observations of patrons relating to the proposed 2017-18 budget.
2. Open meeting law guidelines, posted on east wall in room, were brought to the attention of all by President Stanczyk.
3. Superintendent Sissel presented the land valuation trend, lid computation requirements, explained budget authority, cash reserves, and shared the proposed 2017-18 budget.
4. There being no public comment, the hearing was closed at 6:48 PM by President Stanczyk, with no decisions being made.

The next regular meeting follows the hearing to set the final tax request for the 2017-18 budget scheduled for Noon on September 11, 2017 in the Garden County High School Board Room.
